Outhouse Structure Rules

- Minimum dimensions 3' long and 3' wide and 6' high. Must have three (3) sides, a sloped roof, and an opening front door; may have side windows 12" by 12" max.
- Must be constructed out of solid material such as wood, metal, or composite materials. No cardboard, plastic film, cloth or chicken wire.
- Must have four (4) wheels mounted no more than 10" outside of walls.
- Grasping devices for pushers may not exceed 24". No ropes. Maximum width 6'.
- Must be human powered. No motors or pedals allowed.
- Must contain a roll of toilet paper.
- Each outhouse should have its name or theme displayed on the outhouse and at least one (1) team member sits on it during the race. The seat must be attached securely to the outhouse and the rider may hold on to some type of grasping device, suggested for safety reasons. No explicit language or pornographic displays allowed on or in the outhouse.
- Outhouses will race 2 at a time. The winner will move on to the next heat.
- We would appreciate your outhouse resembling an actual outhouse, since it is an "outhouse" race.

Team Rules

- Up to five (5) people can be on each team and one (1) person must ride inside the outhouse.
- A helmet is strongly recommended for all participants but the team member riding in the outhouse IS REQUIRED to wear a helmet.
- The outhouse participants must be at least 14 years old. There is no weight limit for the riders.
